Each board must demonstrate readiness to accept this responsibility. The boards may also develop, or obtain proposals for, a petition for regional services for consideration by the state behavioral health authority.</p> <p>Joy asked everyone to keep above in mind as the subcommittee looks at what they are doing in the next year and when the new RFP comes.</p> <p>Continue brainstorming at what a recovery center looks like. We have identified the problems, but what do we do about it? Joy suggested having recovery</p>

Look at this by county by county instead of just by the region as a whole.</p> <p>What can we do to be prepared for January and be ready for fiscal agent in the next year. Joy asked for possible people to attend a brainstorm session and for people to bring people with them/into the group to help build gaps and needs analyst, especially people from the countries not currently represented in the board, i.e., Owyhee, Payette, Washington, or Adams.</p> <p>Darren – look at training that healthcare and behavioral health services need.</p> <p>Tara asked for a write up to send out to people to recruit people. Joy reminds that our group is mental health, and some groups are overall committee health. Two hours is a good time frame. February is suggested, March goes into spring break. Contact city councils, for lots of our work goes through county commissions. Dept of labor, food banks, community council of aging, identify the resources in the community. Look at money available and how do we get it?</p> <p>Joy, look at dates in February and get lists of people to invite.
