The purpose of the Partnerships for Success (PFS) grant is to prevent underage drinking, and marijuana and methamphetamine use among youth.

Partnerships for Success program updates:

In June, the PFS coordinator continued to work with partners to finish up existing agreements, extend agreements, and discussed and reviewed new projects with partners over the summer. The Emmett City Park project was completed, and the project was unveiled to the public during the Cherry Festival. A Positive Action for parents cohort, taught by an Insight Counseling & Therapy intern, finished in late May. In coordination with the SWDH tobacco prevention and cessation program coordinator, 23 youth scholarships and 2 adult chaperone scholarships were provided to Idaho Drug Free Youth's (IDFY) Idaho Youth Summit in Coeur D'Alene.

PFS assisted the Canyon County Drug Free Coalition (2CDFC) in preparing and printing materials for a parent educational and awareness packet that they are distributing at their community events. A Save My Family parent educational event took place in Cambridge, Idaho in June. 25 residents attended to learn from the panel of experts.

In addition to assisting partners in their implementation and agreement adherence and wrap up, the coordinator worked with the Idaho Office of Drug Policy to develop a plan for summer implementation to continue PFS work through early September, and applied to a new Partnerships for Success Grant available through Substance Abuse Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA).
