<u>Recovery Coach Training funding:</u> The request for the "BPA" to fund recovery coach trainers from BPA for a one-week training. This request was for \$3,000.

The other request is for \$5,850.00 for a 40hour training for Peer Support training for 10 individuals. To increase the number of people who are certified peer support coaches.

Sean asked if these requests were on behalf of the CMH Subcommittee, not for services directly from BPA.

<u>Peer Support Training funding:</u> Joy reminded people that the Peer Support training would happen over a one-week period and not be carried over time.

Joy mentioned that the Recovery Coach Training would help support a much-needed training in a rural area.

There were questions regarding if there is a need for recovery coaches in the community and if there are organizations looking to hire these positions.
