<p>Recovery Ecosystem Planning and Development Update: Payette and Washington Counties did not place the Three Rivers Recovery Community Center (TRRCC) into their opioid settlement funding budgets. We did not hear back from Adams County. There is still great community support to move forward with a recovery ecosystem, to include the Tri-County mental health and drug courts, therefore we will be moving forward based on direction from the Board.</p> <p>Marti with the SWIRCC shared that she has been working to help develop a recovery center in Payette and brought several people to the Board meeting.</p>

This would be a volunteer position until further funding</li> <li>✓ At minimum one member from the R3 Board will hold a seat on the TRRCC board for as long as the R3 Board is funding any work on TRRCC for reporting purposes</li> <li>✓ Share funding opportunities to sustain TRRCC to generate a project timeline for the TRRCC board</li> <li>• Ensure the TRRCC board is ready to receive the space funded by the R3 BHB (\$15,00), \$3,000 in travel vouchers, and donated time from certified peer and recovery coaches</li> <li>• Transfer TRRCC DBA, apply for non-profit status through the Idaho Secretary of State, obtain a checking account with a minimum of two signatures required</li> </ul>
